The Village of Craven has a Fireworks Bylaw.

This is to ensure the safety, health or welfare of the people in the municipality. This is also to inform the Fire Department and to make sure that no fire bans are currently set in place.

Fireworks Bylaw 12-2024 states that any person who wishes to set off fireworks in the municipality must obtain a fireworks permit from the Administrator. Fireworks may only be set off on private property or other places only when a permit is approved.
