

BYLAW NO. 04-2022
THE VILLAGE OF CRAVEN
UNCLAIMED PERSONAL PROPERTY BYLAW

The Council of the Village of Craven in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) This bylaw may be cited as The Unclaimed Personal Property Bylaw.
- 2) The purpose of this bylaw is to provide for the disposition of lost and unclaimed personal property in the possession of the Village.
- 3) In this bylaw:
 - a) "Council" means the Council of the Village of Craven;
 - b) "Designated Officer" means a person designated by Council to deal with unclaimed personal property;
 - c) "Earlier Owner" means a person who has established a claim to the personal property prior to that of the Village or the Owner, but does not include an Owner;
 - d) "Owner" means a person who obtains unclaimed personal property from the Village; and
 - e) "Village" means the Village of Craven.
- 4) This Bylaw shall apply to all unclaimed personal property in the possession of the Village.
- 5) The Village of Craven shall retain all unclaimed personal property in its possession for 90 days, except as provided in Section 6.
- 6) Any perishable unclaimed property in the Village's possession may be disposed of as soon as practicable after the property is received by the Village.
- 7) If personal property is not claimed within the time limit specified in Section 5, it becomes the property of the Village, and the Village may dispose of the property:
 - a) By donating it to any person or organization; or
 - b) By offering it for sale at public auction.
- 8) Any personal property offered for sale at a public auction pursuant to Section 7 that is not sold may be disposed of in any manner that a Designated Officer may direct.
- 9) A person who acquires personal property from the Village becomes the Owner of the personal property.
- 10) The person who buys unclaimed personal property at a public auction is the Owner of that property.

11) Chief Administrative Officer and Public Works Foreman are appointed as Designated Officers for the purposes of this Bylaw.

12) A Designated Officer is authorized to further delegate his or her powers or duties under this Bylaw to an employee or agent of the Village.

13) This Bylaw comes into force on the day of its final passing.
