

VILLAGE OF CRAVEN

Bylaw number 1-83

A BYLAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS:

CRAVEN HALL

AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL, HISTORICAL or NATURAL VALUE

WHEREAS Part III of The Heritage Property Act, 1980, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural, historical or natural value or interest;

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Craven has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as Craven Hall on Lot 21B, Block 4 in the Village of Craven, a Notice of Intention to so designate the aforesaid real property, and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least seven (7) days prior to the date of that consideration;

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Craven enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of historical value or interest, the real property known as Craven Hall on Tennant Street, and legally described as lot 21B, Block 4, Plan BD655.
The significance of the site is Historical.
2. The municipal clerk is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister of Culture and Youth, and to cause notice of the passing of this bylaw.

Read three times and passed unanimously, this 6th day of June, 1983.
