

Lagoon Access Bylaw

Village of Craven

Bylaw No. 10-2024

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAVEN, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, FOR DUMPING LIQUID DOMESTIC WASTE HAULED TO THE VILLAGE OF CRAVEN LAGOON

The Council of the Village of Craven of the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. CONTROL

- a) That the Village of Craven wastewater lagoon system be controlled at all times under lock and key.
- b) Issuance of a key to access the lagoon is \$25.00 per key.
- c) A permit must be obtained from the Village of Craven before dumping liquid domestic waste into the Lagoon System.
- d) A valid and subsisting business license is required and fees have been paid in accordance with the Business Licensing Bylaw.

2. REGULATE

- a) Only those septic haulers that have been approved by the Village of Craven will be permitted to haul domestic waste to the lagoon.
 - a. An application to Dispose of Domestic Waste identified as Exhibit "A" in this Bylaw;
 - b. A copy of their Permit to Transport and Dispose of Domestic Waste as issued by the Saskatchewan Water Security Agency.
 - c. A copy of their liability insurance policy that demonstrates a minimum \$2,000,000.00 (Two Million Dollars) liability threshold.
- b) The Village may ask the hauler to supply sufficient records and licensing as requested.
- c) Upon approval of the application, a Permit to Dispose of Domestic Waste identified as Exhibit "B" in this Bylaw shall be issued.
- d) The Village has the right to deny the acceptance of domestic waste and all other effluent that may not conform to the requirements of the Permit to Operate a Sewage Works as issued by the Saskatchewan Water Security Agency.
- e) The Village, at its discretion, may require a septic hauler to provide sample testing prior to depositing any domestic waste at the Village's lagoon if, in the opinion of the Village, the effluent being hauled may contain materials and chemicals that are deemed to be hazardous or dangerous to the environment.
- f) The septic hauler shall be responsible for all costs relating to performing the required tests and submitting analysis information to the Village for review.

- g) Each approved septic hauler must agree to keep the gate locked at all times and to not allow other septic haulers to access the lagoon with their key.
- h) Approved septic haulers are not allowed to keep the gate open to allow multiple trucks to access the lagoon.
- i) Septic haulers found to be in breach of this bylaw will have their access revoked to the lagoon.
- j) Any septic hauler found to be hauling domestic waste to the Village's lagoon without a valid permit, as issued by the Village, or found to be depositing hazardous or environmentally sensitive waste without proper authorization shall be guilty of an offence as per Subsection 381 of the Municipalities Act.
- k) Any septic hauler found to be responsible for damages to the lagoon, including damages to the berm, road, fence, or other related structures, will be required to cover the costs of the repair, and could potentially be evicted from using the facility.
- l) Bylaw No. 03/95 is hereby repealed.
- m) This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of adoption by the Village of Craven Council.
