


BYLAW NO. 2 - 95


A bylaw to compel the removal of dirt, stones, filth or rubbish from public places.

The Council of the Village of Craven of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. No person shall throw, place, deposit or leave on any street, sidewalk, road, highway, lane, or other public place in the Village any dirt, stones, filth or rubbish.
2. Any person throwing, placing depositing, or having on any public place in the Village any dirt, stones, filth or rubbish shall within twenty-four hours after having been notified by the council, the health officer, or any Village official acting on their behalf, remove said dirt, stones, filth or rubbish and place same where directed by the notice, and in default of so doing the council may order removal at the expense of the person in default and the Village may recover the expenses thereof with costs by action in any court of competent jurisdiction or in like manner as Village taxes.
3. The payment of a fine for infraction of this bylaw shall not relieve the person in default from liability under section 2 hereof.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty bylaw of the Village.
